Born in Phuket, Thailand, I have always raced under the Thai flag. Having a wealth of experience in karts, open-wheel cars up to F2, touring cars, and GT cars, my racing career has gone further than I could have ever expected when I first sat down in a kart at the age of 4.

2008 was my final year of karting, I participated in and won the Asian Karting Open Championship (AKOC) in the Rotax Max Jr. Class. This opened up the doors for me to venture into single-seaters in the form of Asian Formula Renault. I competed in the series in 2010 and became the youngest ever champion, and the first driver from Thailand to win the championship.

From there I moved to compete in Europe, and after a couple of years developing myself, I entered the European Formula 3 Open championship and narrowly missed out on the title. In 2014 I stayed in the series and convincingly won the championship with a round to spare. From there I moved to the GP3 Series, and did multiple days of post-season testing in GP2. In the end, my sponsorship was not enough to make the step up to the series, so I looked for more long-term racing options for my future. I decided on the GT3 category, and have had success in Blancpain Asia with a few podiums in my years of racing there.

I returned to Thai racing in 2019, and won the Thailand Super Series championship twice in a row. After my success in 2019, I became an Official Audi Sport Asia factory driver, and represented the brand in the 2020 and 2021 seasons respectively.

In recent years I have also been involved in the racing and development of Ford Thailand's Ranger race truck, and we have seen good success with the platform.
